



2019 BULK HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION

In an effort to defray rising bulk waste collection and disposal costs, while at the same time enhancing the level of service to residents, changes were made to curbside collection of bulk household waste in 2018. Bulk collection is now held twice per calendar year on the *first Friday in May (Friday, May 3rd, 2019)* and the *third Friday in September (Friday, September 20th, 2019)*. The following are the guidelines for bulk collection:

- Bulk collection requires a sticker, which is to be affixed to items to be discarded. One sticker covers up to **500 pounds** of material. ***No items will be picked up without a sticker!!!***
- **One (1) sticker** will be issued per household or address currently receiving regular weekly trash pickup from the Borough's contracted waste hauler, per collection date, free of charge. Additional stickers (each covering an additional **500 pounds** of material) will be available for purchase at a cost of **\$25.00 each**.
- Stickers will be available for pickup during normal business hours (**8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.**) at Borough Hall Monday through Friday. Stickers may also be picked up anytime between **8:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.** on the following dates:

MAY BULK COLLECTION

- Tuesday, February 19th
- Tuesday, March 5th
- Tuesday, March 19th
- Tuesday, April 2nd
- Tuesday, April 16th*

SEPTEMBER BULK COLLECTION

- Tuesday, May 21st
- Tuesday, June 18th
- Tuesday, July 2nd
- Tuesday, August 6th
- Tuesday, September 3rd**

- The last day to pick up stickers will be **Tuesday, April 16th** and **Tuesday, September 3rd** for the May and September cleanups, respectively.
- In order to obtain stickers residents must show proof of address in the form of government issued personal identification or a utility bill.
- Stickers are only valid for the bulk collection date listed on sticker.
- Residents shall have **60 days** from the date of the last bulk collection of the year (until **Wednesday, November 20, 2019**) to redeem stickers purchased but not utilized.
- Stickers should be affixed to items unlikely to be picked up by scavengers (i.e.: metal items, furniture, etc.)
- Items placed curbside for bulk collection without a sticker affixed will not be picked up and property owners will be subject to fines.
- See “Yes, we will pick up, No, we won’t pick up” on the reverse for acceptable Bulk collection items.
- **Please note that allowing individuals from outside of the Borough to bring in items for disposal results in higher disposal costs for all Borough residents!**
