OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. JML Landscaping- Payment for Phase II of the Cool Communities Grant (\$12,320.00) will be postponed until K. Halpin contacts Joe Bennett, Forester/Grants Coordinator. Mr. Bennett is required to inspect the trees that were planted with the grant funds.
- 2. 54 Alvin Sloan Ave.- L. Starita will contact the owners regarding the replacement of their R.O.W. tree without notifying the Commission. The owners never responded to the Shade Tree Commission's written request to identify the species of tree that was planted.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. 2009 Green Communities Grant- \$3,000.00 is awarded to hire a qualified expert to create a Community Forestry Management Plan. A motion was made by K. Halpin and seconded by L. Starita to contact Tom Doty for this position and Paul Cowie as a second choice. Both consultants were on the recommended list provided by the NJ Division of Parks & Forestry.

- 2. 64 Grand Avenue- Owners (Kenneth & Pat Chambers) request to have a hazardous tree removed was granted. Peterson & Son provided a quote of \$420.00 to remove the tree and stump. A letter went out to notify the homeowners regarding this action.
- 3. 36 Grand Avenue- Owners (Daniel & Paula Aron) reported fallen limbs from their R.O.W. tree. The fallen branches fell across a pathway that is frequently used by children walking to school. K. Halpin will contact Jeremy Summit to evaluate the tree before the next Shade Tree Meeting. Peterson & Son will remove the fallen branches which the homeowner placed by the curb.
- 4. CORE Training Workshop- K. Clark and L. Ferguson plan to attend this workshop which is scheduled for February 28, 2009 in Paramus, NJ.

5. Shade Tree Commission designated areas- The Borough map was sectioned off to assign each Commissioner to a specific part of town. All questions received at the Municipal building will be forwarded to the Commissioner who is responsible for the relevant area.
