OLD BUSINESS:

- 1. Green Communities Grant Paul Cowie, the consultant who will update the CFMP requested Accomplishment Reports from the last five years and a Purchase Order for the cost of his service. These documents were sent to Mr. Cowie along with an invitation to meet with the Shade Tree Commission at the September 9th meeting.
- Inventory List Review- The Commission agreed to extend the town tree inventory
 assessment until the September meeting. This will allow the Commissioners to
 thoroughly evaluate the current inventory list in their assigned sections of the Borough.

 The hours will be recorded in the Green Community Grant report.
- 3. Quotes for the 2013 Maintenance List- Quotes for (10) trees and stump removals and (1) trim were sent to the Commission. A Motion was made by G. Pohorely and seconded by S. Marr that the Commission use Sunshine Tree & Landscape to do the necessary maintenance at designated locations.

Halpin visited the location and determined that the trees in the area need to be elevated. The location will be added to the Maintenance List for trimming at a later time.
- 4. 3 Grand Avenue- Chairman, K. Halpin reported a town tree that was dying and suggested that it be added the current Maintenance List as a removal.
